(A) Graphic Designer

- Conceptualize and design documents, reports, brochures, booklets, newsletters as a part of the communications team at CDRI.
- Create branding material, web-based pages, GIFs, graphics/infographics/artwork (for social media and reports).
- Undertake image editing, create interactive pdfs/infographics, and other design material for CDRI as emergent.

(B) Video Editor

- Create, curate, and edit videos as per CDRI's requirements.
- Review, re-work/Edit videos created by external agencies.



- (C) Working closely with Line Manager to plan and deliver on multiple tasks and ensure an effective work management plan.
- (D) Periodic reporting orally and in writing, as required, to the Line Manager.
