Position

This position will be based at the CDRI secretariat in New Delhi, India, as a full-time staff with a Fixed Term Contract of three (3) years, renewable for an additional three (3) years. The position is open to Indian and Foreign Nationals.

Objective of the position

CDRI is looking for an experienced professional for the position of Analyst (Partnerships) to work under the supervision of the Lead Specialist on the following deliverables, but not limited to:

 Conduct prospect research, mapping opportunities, and relationship management for building partnerships and engagement with members, including global experts in Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), Climate change, Infrastructure, and resilience.



- Prepare and maintain systematic documentation of the ongoing engagements with members and partners, keep track of updates, meeting records, etc., including governance and resource mobilization-related activities.
- Maintaining and regularly updating the database and reports relevant to the partnerships function.
- Coordinating with internal functions of the organization to collate information, pitch decks, reports, update documents, and information packets.
- Initiate contacts with prospects to qualify, nurture the relationships, and provide support in scheduling meetings for senior management.
- Support in developing and implementing engagement strategy for CDRI with relevant stakeholders.
- Update and manage the Digital CRM System.
- Assist with other duties as may be assigned.
