

Welcome & Administrative Note

Dear participant,

We are delighted to welcome you to Nice for ICDRI 2025. Please find below some important information to support your planning and attendance at the conference.

General Information

- The local emergency telephone number is 112.
- Tap water is safe to drink in France.
- Business hours: most shops in Nice are open between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. from Monday to Saturday. Shops are generally closed on Sundays, but basic goods can be found in supermarkets.

Weather Conditions in Nice

- June in Nice is typically pleasant, with daytime temperatures ranging from 22°C (71°F) to 26°C (79°F). Scattered showers are expected, with temperatures dipping to 13°C (55°F) at night.
- You are advised to carry light summer clothing, a light jacket and a compact umbrella when moving outdoors. A light sweater, jacket, or formal suit may be useful for cooler evenings or indoor sessions.

Currency

The currency in France is the Euro (€). Major credit/debit cards are accepted widely. It is advisable to carry some cash for small purchases.

Travel Adaptor

In Nice, France, you'll primarily encounter Type C and Type E power outlets. Type C has two round pins, while Type E adds a grounding pin. Most modern devices will be compatible with the 230V voltage and 50Hz frequency.

Travel Insurance

You are encouraged to purchase adequate travel insurance.

Local Travel

Nice is well connected by public transport. Trams, buses, trains and taxis are readily available. Several train stations provide regional and national connections. App-based services such as Uber also operate in the region.

Arrivals

Nice has an extensive tramway system. We advise taking a tram ticket at the airport with multiple stops paid in advance. Please see the Annexure II for a map of the tram network.

- Nice-Ville is the main train station in Nice is in the center of the city. And all ICDRI hotels are a short walk from here. Mercure and Best Western can also be accessed by a short tram ride.

ICDRI 2025 is being organized within the **UNOC Green Zone**, at **Nice's Palais des Expositions**. ICDRI sessions will be organized on **Level 2 of the La Baleine** (The Whale). The **Nautilus Auditorium** will be used for Plenary Sessions, and the **Medusa Room** will be used for Roundtable Discussions and Parallel Sessions.

The conference venue is a 2-minute walk from **Palais des Expositions (Exhibition Center)** tram stop on Tram Line 1.

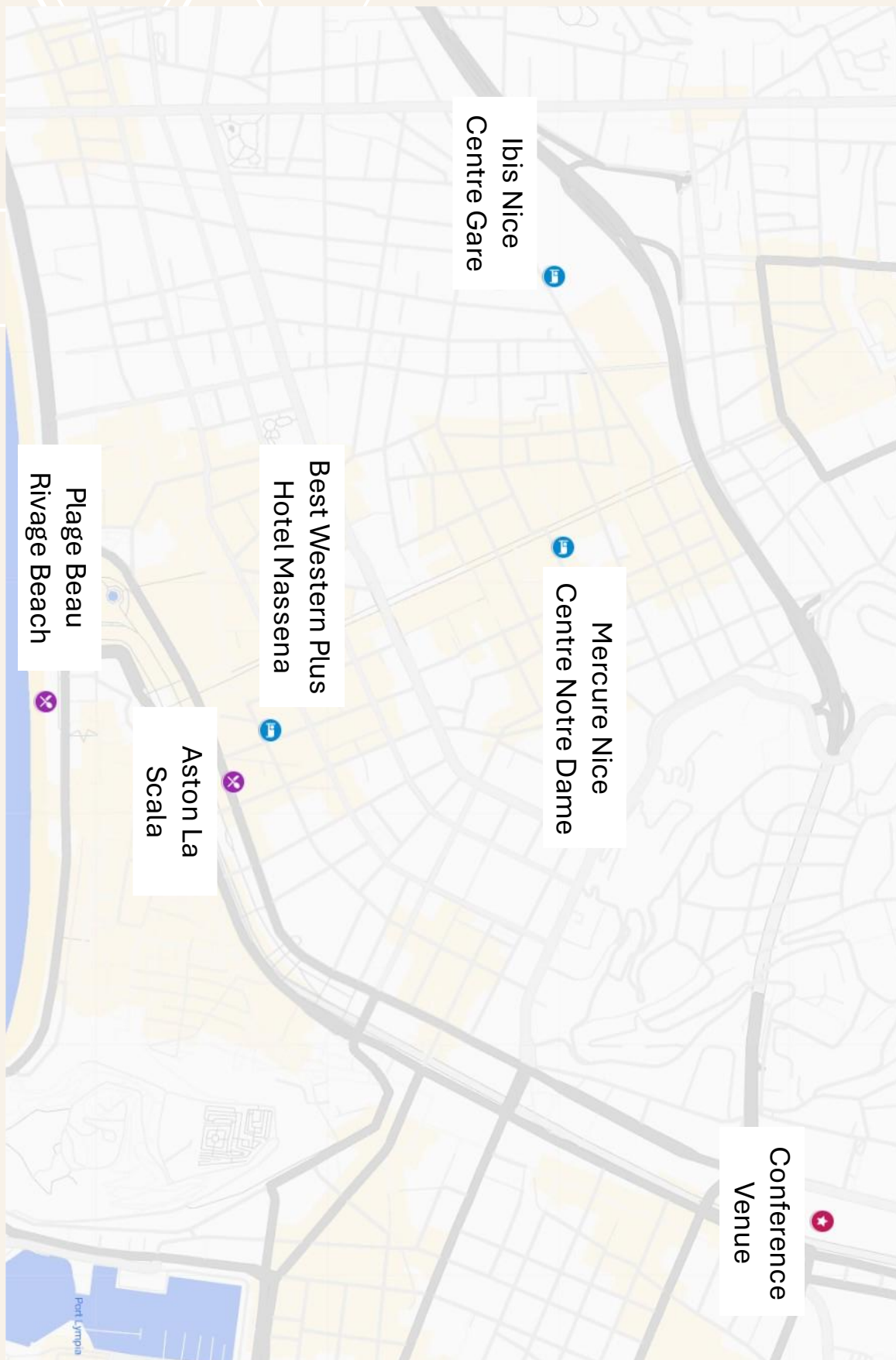
